<u>The Gan Gani / Kesher @ Moadon Parent Association (PA)</u>	
<p>The purpose of the Gan Gani / Kesher Parent Association is to build a sense of community and to provide a strong communication link between the parent body and the school. Every parent or guardian of a Gan Gani or Kesher student is automatically a member of the PA, which holds quarterly meetings and sponsors a host of all-school events and volunteer opportunities. PA meetings are an excellent way to meet fellow parents, learn how to get involved, and find out what's happening at the school. The PA seeks to foster positive relationships between parents and the school's administration, faculty, staff, and Board members. Throughout the year, the PA works with the school to develop activities and events that foster a sense of community.</p>	
<p><u>The Ambassador Program</u></p> <p>The Ambassador Program is designed to facilitate a smooth transition into the new school year for new families through family-to-family relationships. The program pairs an incoming family with an existing Gan Gani or Kesher family to help them become better and more easily integrated into the community. An Ambassador Family welcomes new families to the school, introduces them to other families, answers questions, and introduces children for play dates. Ambassadors are also asked to attend one of two summer play dates on site. (Dates and times to be announced in the kickoff email.)
